How does Credit Recovery work?

- If the pretest score is less than 85%, the student must view every content item in the unit. When all items have been completed, the post test will be available to the student.
- In order to move out of one unit into the next, the student must score a 70% or higher on the unit post test.
- Only unit post tests/final exams/EOC assessments are recorded in the final grade. Students must complete the entire course and the final exam or EOCT to receive credit from the course.
 - 22 weeks to complete course
 - Planning to add physics and anatomy/physiology
 - Re-enrollment fee of \$25 (started Fall 2015)
 - 94% pass rate
